SECONDHAND

Bulkers: as the year draws to end, this week has seen possibly more transactions concluded than one might expect given the lackluster state of the markets. Downward pressure continues to erode pricing although this curve appears to be softening and with Christmas approaching there is a general lack of urgency from the majority of Buyers. It is unlikely that the market will see any major change of direction until the end of the Chinese New Year festival but with this falling early in the year there are hopes we may yet see a revival in first quarter earnings. That said with the continued lack of confidence in the western markets and the Russia / Ukraine conflict still yet to show any signs of resolution the possibilities for a strong rebound appear remote.

Tankers: the sale of a 108K DWT 2018 Japan built Aframax reported at US\$ 62 million gives a clear demonstration of where values have risen to. This time last year for the sum of US\$ 62 million one could have expected to secure a 115K Aframax order in South Korea or alternatively a two years old Korean built LR2 with approximately US\$ 10 million to spare. Otherwise, overaged tonnage continues to change hands in line with last done levels with any price fluctuation down to specification, surveys, BWTS status, etc.

Recycling: the outlook seems to be more stable. Local plate prices in India and Pakistan have been steady for 1-2 weeks. The INR has settled in the mid-82's but it is being suggested there is some seasonality to this relating to Indian companies' end year dividend outflows. We are expecting end-users to have a little more confidence now but it remains to be seen how this translates to pricing.

We are beginning to see some container candidates. The feeder container "UNI-ARDENT" - about 1,164 TEU built Japan 1998 LDT about 7,099 MT - is reported sold 'as is' Kaohsiung for US\$ 505 - this is a strong level when one takes the ballast voyage costs into account. It is not stated but we suspect it may be for Green recycling. Wan Hai are inviting offers on Friday 16th December for 10 x feeder container vessels totalling 62,000 LDT. It will be interesting to see how this unfolds since the size will appeal to many Indian end-users who will want to pick up tonnage before Bangladesh returns. It may also be an interesting speculative opportunity for a cash buyer who can exploit the likely end-user competition there will be.

The Capesize "PASCHALIS D" - about 170,188 tdw built Samho 2002 LDT about 22,908 MT - invited 'as is' Singapore offers this week which opened up in the 490's. We are awaiting the outcome. These owners sell on a non-Green basis and usually the vessel would be destined for Bangladesh so it will be interesting to see if anyone speculates on the Bangladesh L/C restrictions being lifted or the price calculation will be based on the Indian market.
